- Income Based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Pension Credit (Guarantee Credit).
- Tax Credits (Income related).
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance.

What type of work is considered?

The grant covers a wide range of essential repairs, adaptations and improvements including:

- Repairs to leaking roofs and guttering.
- New door and window locks.
- Replacements for draughty and rotten windows and doors.
- Central heating repairs and installation.
