Significant variances from Accounting Statement:

2 Precept up from £5,800 to £7,300

As agreed at our November 2022 meeting, the precept increased by £500 to cover expected additional expenditure specifically public liability insurance, clerk's salary and village grass cutting.

- Total other receipts down from £1,359 to £975

  The previous financial year included a one off payment for participating in online asset mapping of £219 and increased VAT reclaim on expenditure.
- All other payments up from £3,766 to £4,819
  13 village grass cuts were undertaken through the year against 10 the previous year. The Council also purchased a Book of Remembrance for the late Queen, replaced the dog waste bin in Manor Road, Hanging Houghton and replaced the 'no parking on grass verges' signage in Manor Road.
- 9. Fixed assets up from £33,866 to £37,746
  The bulk of the increase relates to the revaluation of the telephone box (now housing the defibrillator), which was adopted from BT for a nominal sum of £1, but it's true value is estimated at £3,000.
